Report of the RSNA Bylaws and Resolutions Committee November 2016

The Bylaws and Resolutions Committee has reviewed and approved a proposal of the Board of Directors that the Bylaws be amended to provide that a Corresponding member is eligible to be elected as an RSNA Vice President.

The RSNA Bylaws currently provide that only Active members of the Society are eligible to serve as an officer or member of an RSNA Board. To be eligible for status as an Active member, a person must reside and practice in a North American country. Members outside of North America have Corresponding member status. Recognizing the increasingly important role played by Corresponding members in carrying out the mission of RSNA, it is proposed that they be eligible to serve as an RSNA Vice President.

The Bylaws and Resolutions Committee recommends that the proposed amendment be approved by the membership. Full text of the amendment can be found in the November issue of Radiology.
