Instructions for Thursday Night Poster Session RSNA Clinical Trials Methodology Course

The poster is simply a guide to stimulate conversation with course participants and faculty who are not familiar with your project. Spend no more than 20 minutes creating it – it need not be perfect!

It should be about 4, and no more than 6, 8 ½" x 11" pages mounted 2 or 3 above and 2 or 3 below eye level on one of the poster boards and readable from a distance of about 3 feet (font size suggested below). It will be similar to the protocol plan you submitted last spring in your application, but modified by the work you've done on it this week.

Simply selectively cut and paste from your final developed proposal – make it telegraphic and bullet-based if need be to fit onto 4 (or 6) pages.

Use the following headers as a template:

Name and Institution Page 1. Background and Hypothesis

Page 2. Specific Aim(s) Abstract (very brief)

Schema

Page 3. Page 4. Statistical considerations:

- Primary aim analysis (brief paragraph)
- Cohort size, expected rate of accrual, and study duration.
- Expected challenges
