Jack L. Coffey is Sr. Vice President of Quality and Regulatory Affairs for the Nuclear Pharmacy Services (NPS) business of Cardinal Health. He is a radiobiologist and a certified health physicist. He spent ten years in radiopharmaceutical research at Oak Ridge Associated Universities (ORAU) prior to joining the businesses that have evolved into the Cardinal NPS business.
