Sally W. Schwarz received her Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy from the University of Iowa in 1971, and a Master of Science in Radiopharmacy from the University of Southern California in 1976. She is Board Certified in Nuclear Pharmacy (BCNP) by the American Pharmacists Association (APhA) Board of Pharmaceutical Specialties, since 1989.

Following her graduate education, Ms. Schwarz was appointed to a faculty position at Washington University, St. Louis, MO in the Department of Radiology (the Divisions of Nuclear Medicine and Radiological Sciences). Ms. Schwarz current position is a Research Associate Professor, and serves as the Director of Clinical PET Radiopharmaceutical production. She is the Secretary for the Radioactive Drug Research Committee for Washington University.

She serves as Chairman of the SNM Pharmacopeia Committee, and is a vice-president elect for the SNM Radiopharmaceutical Sciences Board of Director. She is also active in the APhA, and is currently a member of the Regulatory Affairs Committee member for the Nuclear Pharmacy Section.

In 2008 Ms. Schwarz completed her 6th year on the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Advisory Committee on the Medical Use of Isotopes (ACMUI) as the Nuclear Pharmacy expert. She was appointed in 2008 to the USP Radiopharmaceuticals and Medical Imaging Expert Committee, and serves on the Editorial Board for the Continuing Education for Nuclear Pharmacists and Nuclear Medicine Professionals at the University of New Mexico, College of Pharmacy.
